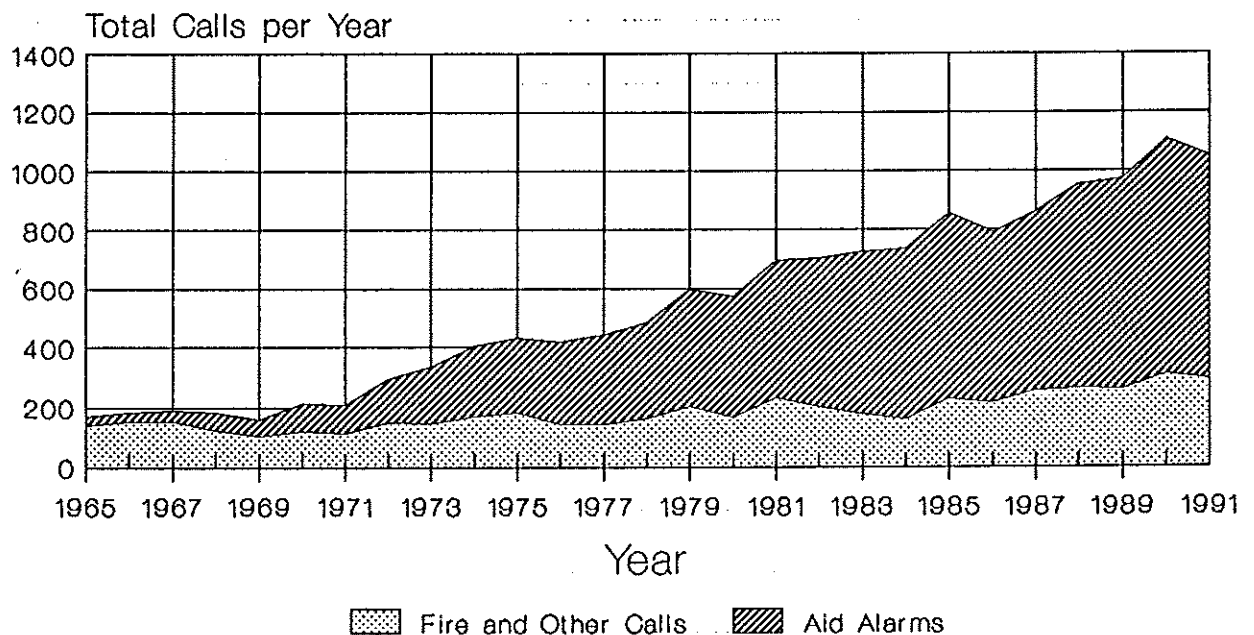

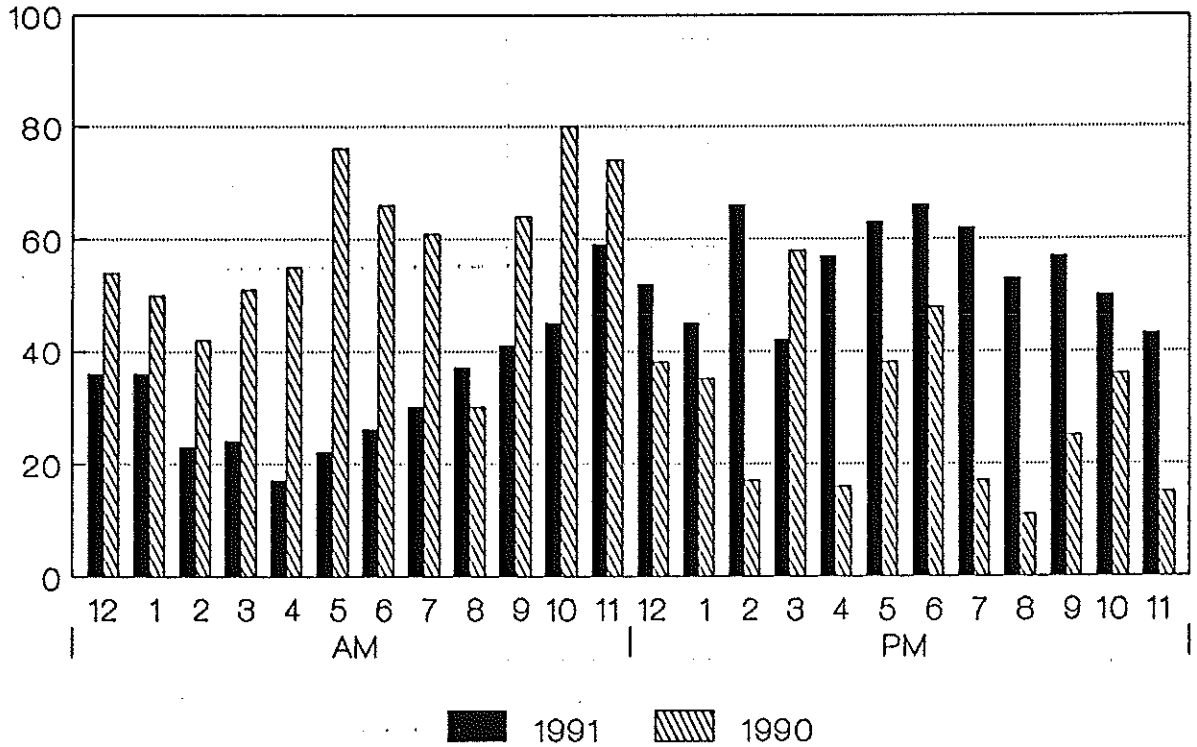

1991/1990 ALARMS

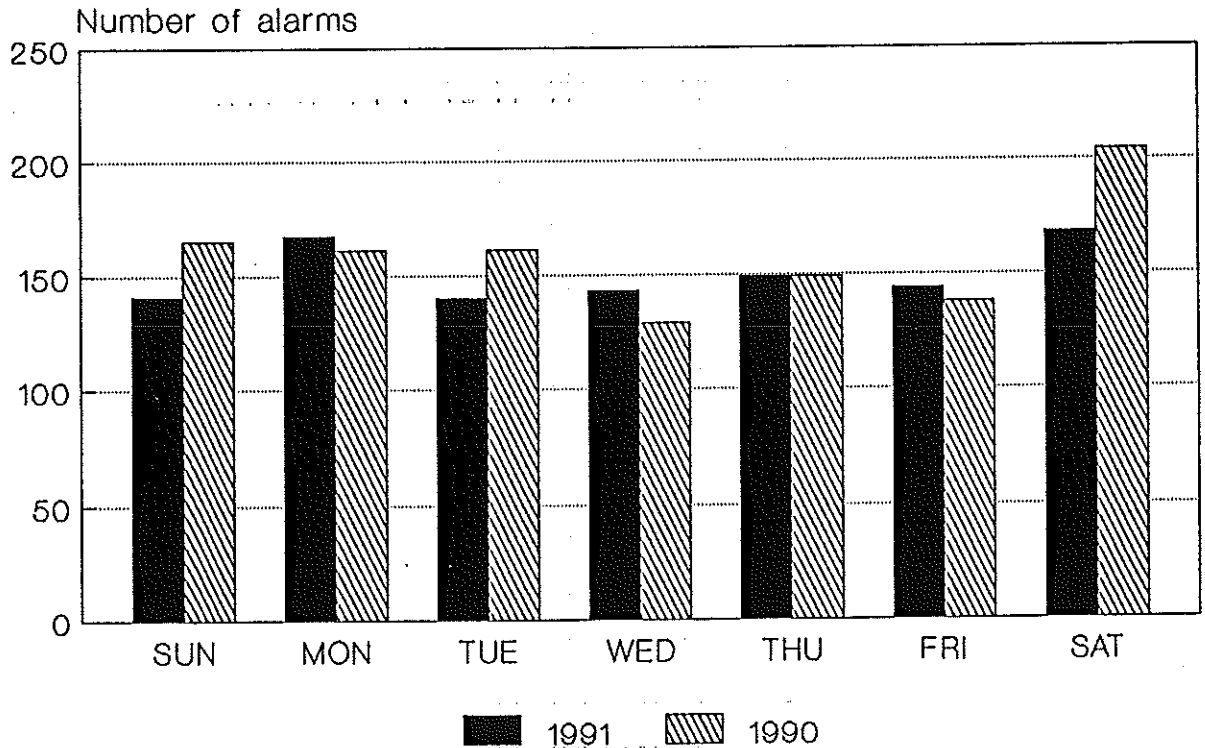
By Time of Day

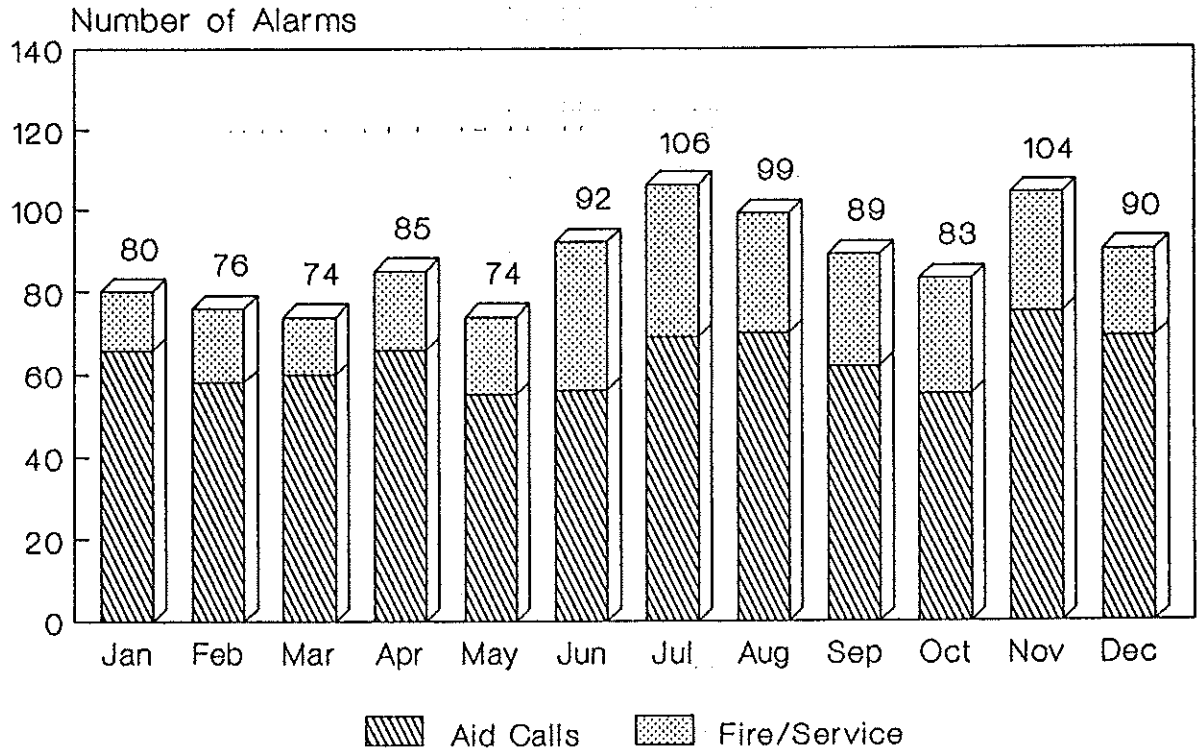
1991/1990 ALARMS By Day of Week

1991 Alarms By Month

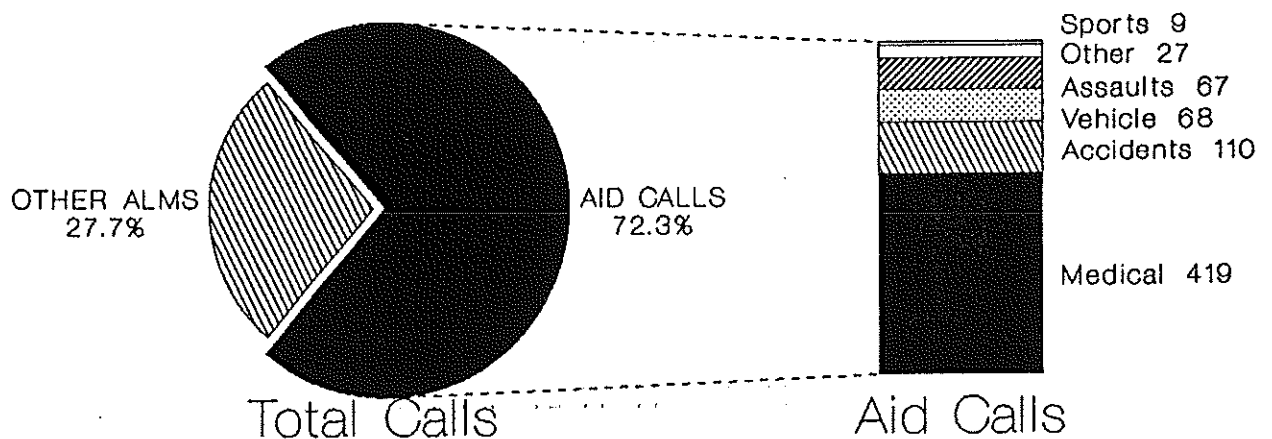

Total Calls to Aid calls

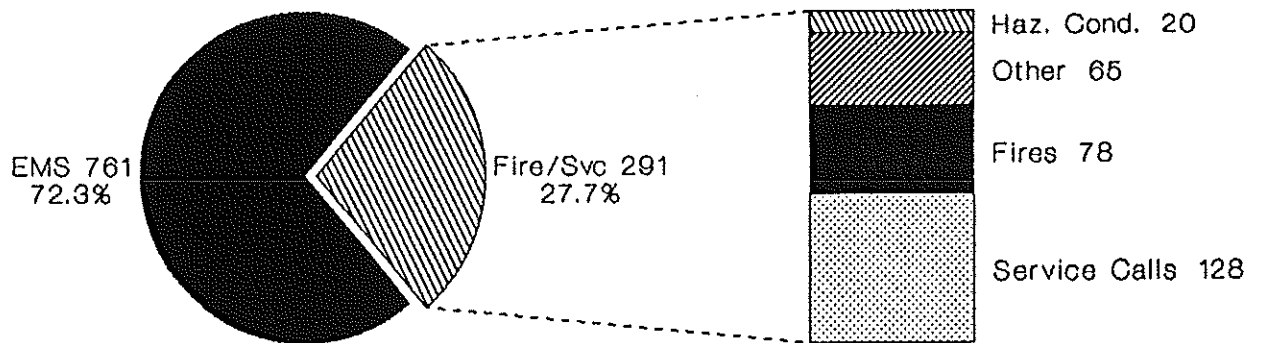

Fire Alarms to All



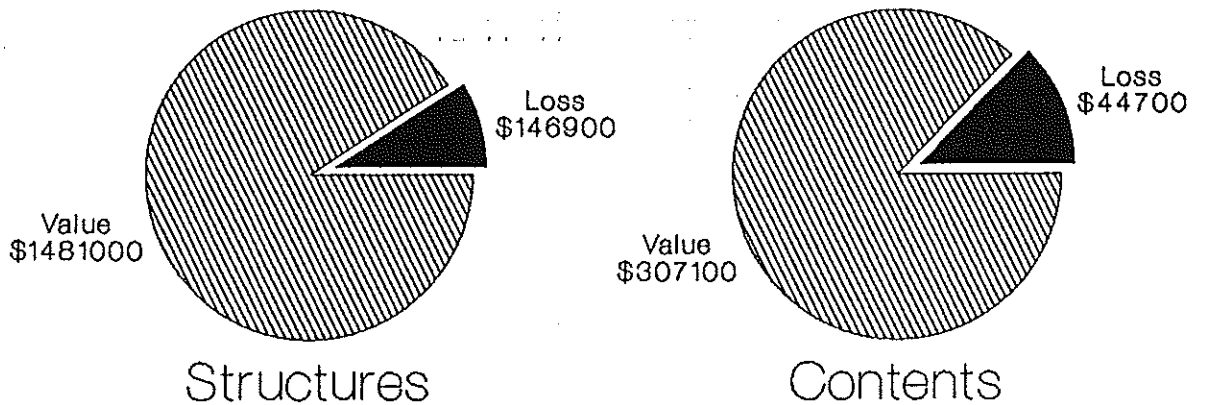
EMS/Fire Responses: Fire Response by Type
